

Hoover Dam

The Boulder Canyon Project (Hoover Dam) consists of 17 hydroelectric generating units located approximately 25 miles from Las Vegas, Nevada. Forty-six (46) participants within the states of AZ, CA and NV participate in the Hoover Dam project. Southern California Public Power Authority members have obtained entitlements totaling 665 MW (32% of the Plant Capacity, of which Anaheim has 1.9477%) through Power Sales Agreements with SCPPA.

The new Electric Service Contract commenced upon expiration of the previous Agreement on October 31, 2017, and it expires on September 30, 2067.
