

SoCal Biomethane Project

The City of Anaheim has contracted with SoCal Biomethane, LLC to generate renewable gas derived from food waste diverted from landfills to a digestion and gas production facility located in either Bloomington or Victorville, California. Once produced, the biomethane gas will be delivered to either the Canyon or Magnolia Power Projects through the Southern California Gas Company's pipeline system where it will be used as biomethane gas fuel to generate renewable electricity (3.1 MW) to serve Anaheim's load.

The 20-year contract expires no later than the Commencement Date Deadline of October 1, 2042.
