

ARP-Loyalton Biomass Project

The City of Anaheim, along with nine other California publicly-owned utilities, has contracted with ARP-Loyalton Cogen, LLC for the purchase of renewable biomass electricity from an 18 MW biomass project located in northern California. Transmission is provided by the California Independent System Operator.

This contract provides Anaheim with 0.81 MW of its proportionate share of renewable biomass energy as required pursuant to Senate Bill 859. The 5-year contract expires on April 20, 2023.
