



**NOTICE TO VOTERS OF DATE AFTER WHICH NO ARGUMENTS
FOR OR AGAINST A CITY MEASURE
MAY BE SUBMITTED TO THE ANAHEIM CITY CLERK**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the General Municipal Election is to be held in the City of Anaheim on November 6, 2018, at which there will be submitted to the voters the following measures:

REFERENDUM MEASURE APPROVING DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT NO. 2016-00001 – Shall Anaheim City Council Ordinance No. 6376, which would approve a Development Agreement and provide a vested right to develop a Four Diamond 580-room, eight-story hotel on property located at 1700 S. Harbor Blvd. during the five-year term of that Development Agreement in accordance with governmental approvals and entitlements granted by the City, be adopted?

REFERENDUM MEASURE APPROVING DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT NO. 2016-00002 – Shall Anaheim City Council Ordinance No. 6377, which would approve a Development Agreement and provide a vested right to develop a Four Diamond 634-room, eight-story hotel on property located at 1030 W. Katella Ave. during the five-year term of that Development Agreement in accordance with governmental approvals and entitlements granted by the City, be adopted?

Impartial Analysis: NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to Section 3 of City Council Resolution Nos. 2018-097 and 2018-101, and Section 9280 of the Elections Code, the impartial analysis prepared by the City Attorney of the initiative measure shall be filed in the Office of the City Clerk not later than **5:00 p.m., Friday, August 10, 2018**.
2. Direct Arguments: NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN pursuant to Section 1 of City Council Resolution Nos. 2018-097 and 2018-101, and Section 9282 of the Elections Code, any and all direct arguments for and against the initiative measure shall be filed in the Office of the City Clerk not later than **5:00 p.m., Friday, August 10, 2018**. All arguments shall be accompanied by the information set forth in Section 9283 of the Elections Code.
3. Changes and Withdrawals: NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN pursuant to Section 1 of City Council Resolution Nos. 2018-097 and 2018-101, and Section 9286 of the Elections Code, any change to or withdrawal of any ballot argument must be filed in the Office of the City Clerk not later than **5:00 p.m., Friday, August 10, 2018**.
4. Rebuttals: NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN pursuant to Section 1 of City Council Resolution Nos. 2018-098 and 2018-102, and Sections 9285 and 9287 of the Elections Code, any and all rebuttal arguments for and against the initiative measure shall be filed in the Office of the City Clerk not later than **5:00 p.m., Monday, August 20, 2018**. All arguments shall be accompanied by the information set forth in Section 9285 of the Elections Code.
5. Public Review: NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that any ordinance, impartial analysis or direct argument filed under the authority of the elections code will be available for public examination in the Office of the Anaheim City Clerk for not less than 10-calendar days from the deadline for the filing of the arguments and analysis. Any rebuttal argument filed under the authority of the elections code will be available for public examination in the Office of the Anaheim City Clerk for not less than 10-calendar days from the deadline for filing rebuttal arguments.
