- \$4,835,000 Anaheim Public Financing Authority Revenue Bonds, Series 2010-A (Water System Project) ("the 2010-A Bonds")
- \$29,690,000 Anaheim Public Financing Authority Revenue Bonds, Series 2010-B (Water System Project) ("the 2010-B Bonds") – Build America Bonds
- \$95,885,000 California Municipal Finance Authority Revenue Bonds, Series 2015-A (City of Anaheim Water System Project) ("the 2015-A Bonds")
- \$35,225,000 Anaheim Housing and Public Improvements Authority Revenue Bonds, series 2016-A (Water System Project) ("the 2016-A Bonds")

The 2018 Annual Report is provided pursuant to the covenants made by the Department in connection with the issuance of (i) the 2008 Bonds as required by the Continuing Disclosure Agreement by and between the City and The Bank of New York Trust Company, N.A. dated as of July 9, 2008, (ii) the 2010-A and 2010-B Bonds as required by the Continuing Disclosure Agreement by and between the City and U.S Bank National Association dated as of October 1, 2010, (iii) the 2015-A Bonds as required by the Continuing Disclosure Agreement by and between the City and U.S. Bank National Association dated as of April 1, 2015 and (iv) the 2016-A Bonds as required by the Continuing Disclosure Agreement by and between the City and U.S. Bank National Association dated as of October 1, 2016..

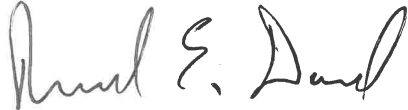

(2) Total Water Production represents all water produced in local wells and purchases from MWD. This differs from water sales, which also accounts for water losses in the system that occur during distribution, and timing differences between actual production and billing.
