Anaheim Resort Safety Bollards Pilot Program**

The City of Anaheim is soliciting proposals from qualified firms or individuals with experience and expertise in the design and installation of safety bollards to provide engineering services to create the Anaheim Resort Safety Bollards Pilot Program to install safety bollards at four (4) street intersections in the City located in The Anaheim Resort®. This includes, but is not limited to, identifying appropriate bollard options for the City of Anaheim, preparing design plans, specifications, bid proposal and bid item level cost estimates to implement and construct the bollards per the plans and provide project management services during the pilot program construction phase (construction of the bollards will be bid separately). The four street intersections include: Harbor Boulevard/East Shuttle Area; Harbor Boulevard/Disney Way; Harbor Boulevard/Katella Avenue; and Harbor Boulevard/Convention Way.
