FOR INFORMATION ONLY, the Department of Public Works is advertising for bids to construct the Modjeska Park Underground Storm Water Detention and Infiltration System in the parking lot of Modjeska Park (1331 South Nutwood Street) adjacent to Nutwood Street. This project will help improve the water quality by reducing pollutants, recharging the ground water, reduce flooding, and increase the reliability of future water supplies. This project is part of the Master Plan of Storm Drainage for Anaheim Barber City Channel Tributary Area (adopted by Anaheim City Council on October 27, 2009 by Resolution No. 2009-163).

The work consists of excavation and grading to install an underground pre-manufactured infiltration/detention system with a pretreatment sedimentation chamber; removal of interfering portions of existing storm drain pipes; construction of a diversion structure; installation of diversion pipes and a trash capture vault; reconstructing the parking lot with permeable pavers; and other items of work required to complete the scope of work detailed in the plans and specifications.

10% bid bond required.

Liquidated Damages will be \$5,500 per day. See Attachment A for additional project information.
