Hug-a-Bye Baby is an infant with parent program for babies 2-12 months old - A warm and cuddly time of bonding with your baby through books! Think of it as twenty minutes of baby bliss!

At "Hug-a-Bye Baby" parents will sit on the floor or a chair with their babies in their laps. The librarian will share baby songs and lullabies, nursery rhymes, fingerplays, age-appropriate picture books and board books, gentle stretching, and ways that parents may stimulate language and baby brain development with their children at home.



Here's what you need to know

- Children need to be in good health with clean diapers.
- Diapers may be changed in the restrooms.
- Children need to remain within arm's length of their parent.
- Please bring a quilt or blanket for your child to rest on. (Our storytime carpet gets a lot of use, and is not clean enough for baby.)
- Comfortable clothing for babies and adults is recommended.
- Please turn off all cell phones and pagers during the program.
- Nursing moms and their babies may use the quiet corner provided in the story space.
- Fussy babies may need to be comforted outside the story area for the sake of the larger group. Some may be able to rejoin the group; some need to come back another day.
- Only baby and parent or parents may attend. Space is limited, and this program is designed for infants and their child care providers only.
- Grown-ups are encouraged to visit together before and after the program.
