### □ YOUR VOTE MATTERS

At the November 4, 2014 election, the electors of Anaheim voted to change the city's electoral system from "At-Large" to a "By-District" system, as well as expanding the City Council from five to seven members (six council members and the mayor).

What does this mean to you for this election year? For the first time in 159 years, council members shall live within their district and only voters living in the district where a council member election is being held (districts 1, 3, 4 & 5) can vote for that council member seat. Districts 2 and 6 will elect a council member in 2018 (Mayor will remain at-large).

Additionally, during this election citizens will not only get to decide who will lead the city but also whether you wish to amend the City Charter relating to Council sponsored tax proposals. Before voters is the question of whether or not the Charter should be amended to require a 2/3 vote of the Council to place a tax proposal on the ballot for voter consideration. City ballot measures will continue to be voted upon by all Anaheim voters (At-Large).

Interested? Remember, voting is a right that only you own. Exercise your vote and think about what your vote will mean to Anaheim; how your vote will continue to shape Anaheim.

## **Council District 1:**

All land within the boundary beginning at the NW corner of Brookhurst Ave. and California Route 91 on the northern boundary of the City, proceeding southerly on Brookhurst Ave. to Crescent Ave.; then proceeding westerly on Crescent Ave. to Magnolia Ave.; then proceeding southerly on Magnolia Ave. to the southern boundary of the City; then proceeding westerly, northerly, and easterly on the boundary of the City to the point of origin.

## **Council District 2:**

All land within the boundary beginning at the NW corner of Brookhurst Ave. and California Route 91 on the northern boundary of the City, proceeding southerly on Brookhurst Ave. to Crescent Ave.; then proceeding westerly on Crescent Ave. to Magnolia Ave.; then proceeding southerly on Magnolia Ave. to the southern boundary of the City; then proceeding easterly on the southern boundary of the City to the intersection of Katella Ave. and Euclid St.; then proceeding northerly on Euclid St. to the intersection of Euclid St. and California Route 91, which is the city boundary; then proceeding westerly on the boundary of the City to the point of origin.

## **Council District 3:**

All land within the boundary beginning at the NW corner of Raymond Ave. and the northern boundary of the City, proceeding southerly on Raymond Ave., which becomes East St. to South St.; then proceeding westerly on South St. to I-5; then proceeding southerly on I-5 to Ball Rd.; then proceeding westerly on Ball Rd. to Walnut St.; then proceeding northerly on Walnut St. to Crone Ave.; then proceeding westerly on Crone Ave. to Euclid St.; then proceeding northerly on Euclid St. to the intersection of Euclid St. and California Route 91, which is the city boundary; then proceeding easterly, northerly and then easterly on the boundary of the City to the point of origin.

## **Council District 4:**

All land within the boundary beginning at the NW corner of Orangewood Ave. and Anaheim Way on the southern boundary of the City, proceeding northerly on Anaheim Way to Lewis St.; then proceeding northerly on Lewis St. to Ball Rd.; then proceeding easterly on Ball Rd. to State College Blvd.; then proceeding northerly on State College Blvd. to Santa Ana St.; then proceeding westerly on Santa Ana St. to East St.; then proceeding southerly on East St. to South St.; then proceeding westerly on South St. to I-5; then proceeding southerly on I-5 to Ball Rd.; then proceeding westerly on Ball Rd. to Walnut St.; then proceeding northerly on Walnut St. to Crone Ave.; then proceeding westerly on Crone Ave. to Euclid St.; then proceeding southerly on Euclid St. to the intersection of Euclid St. and Katella Ave., which is the city boundary; then proceeding easterly on the boundary of the City to the point of origin.

## **Council District 5:**

All land within the boundary beginning at the intersection of Orangethorpe Ave. and the northern boundary of the City, proceeding southwestly on Orangethorpe Ave. to Miller St.; then proceeding southeasterly on Miller St. to La Palma Ave.; then proceeding southwestly on La Palma Ave. to Kraemer Blvd.; then proceeding southeasterly on Kraemer Blvd., which becomes Glassell St., to the southern boundary of the City; then proceeding westerly on the southern boundary of the City to the intersection of Orangewood Ave and Anaheim Way; then proceeding northerly on Anaheim Way to Lewis St.; then proceeding northerly on Lewis St. to Ball Rd.; then proceeding easterly on Ball Rd. to State College Blvd.; then proceeding northerly on State College Blvd. to Santa Ana St.; then proceeding westerly on Santa Ana St. to East St.; then proceeding northerly on East St., which becomes Burton Ave., to the boundary of the City; then proceeding easterly on the boundary of the City to the point of origin.

## **Council District 6:**

All land within the boundary beginning at the intersection of Orangethorpe Ave. and the northern boundary of the City, proceeding southwestly on Orangethorpe Ave. to Miller St.; then proceeding southeasterly on Miller St. to La Palma Ave.; then proceeding southwestly on La Palma Ave. to Kraemer Blvd.; then proceeding southeasterly on Kraemer Blvd., which becomes Glassell St., to the southern boundary of the City; then proceeding easterly, northerly, and westerly on the boundary of the City to the point of origin.
