CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION WASTE DIVERSION APPLICATION INFORMATION

Materials generated from construction projects must be recycled to meet statutory obligations under various State legislation and California Green Building Codes, which require 65% of all debris to be diverted from the landfill.

To meet reporting obligations, the City of Anaheim requires individuals pulling permits with construction and demolition debris **in excess of five (5) tons** to provide information on where the materials will be taken and the percentage of materials diverted from the landfill.

A Construction & Demolition Waste Diversion Application must be submitted **BEFORE** a permit may be issued. There are three options to be compliant in reporting recycling of your C&D materials:

1. Use Republic Services – City’s franchise trash hauler

If you utilize Republic Services to dispose of your debris (rent a dumpster or utilize their transfer station), you are in compliance and do not need to provide additional diversion reporting.

2. Self-haul

Projects generating less than 5 tons of construction and demolition debris must be transported to a facility for proper disposal.

3. Not Using Republic Services

If you will generate over five (5) tons and will be hauling your construction and demolition materials, you are required to complete/provide the following:

- Complete a Construction & Demolition Waste Diversion application to obtain your permit.
- Save all dump and/or recycling receipts.
- You cannot schedule a final inspection if you have not submitted the following:
 - a. Submit updated Construction & Demolition Waste Application forms
 - b. Include all receipts for each commodity or material
 - c. Complete recycling information (location, materials)
 - d. Actual percentage of recycled materials, no less than 65%
