

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Anaheim Housing Authority manages the Housing Choice Voucher (HCV, also known as “Section 8”) program for the City of Anaheim. The Housing Choice Voucher program provides rental assistance to eligible low-income families, which helps them afford safe, quality housing. The Anaheim Housing Authority will open the Housing Choice Voucher program waiting list on Monday, December 2, 2019, for individuals who qualify for the mainstream preference.

To qualify for the mainstream preference, a household member must satisfy all three eligibility criteria: (1) must be between 18 to 61 years old, (2) must be disabled, and (3) must currently be transitioning out of an institutional or other segregated setting, at serious risk of institutionalization, homeless, or at risk of becoming homeless. In order to apply, you must attach verification that you or a member of your household meets all three of the above criteria. Applications without the required documentation attached will be returned to you.

Additional priority is given within the preference to applicants who (a) live or work in the city of Anaheim, and to (b) veteran or current members of the American armed forces and the widowed spouses of veterans.

Pre-applications will be accepted at the Anaheim Housing Authority office located at: 201 S. Anaheim Blvd. Suite 201, Anaheim, CA 92805. You may submit a written request for the Anaheim Housing Authority to send you a pre-application at the following address: 201 S. Anaheim Blvd. Suite 201, Anaheim, CA 92805. To submit your application, you must provide Social Security numbers and birthdates for all members of your family, home and work address information, household income, and verifications that you meet the mainstream preference eligibility criteria.

You will be contacted by mail when your application reaches the top of the waiting list. You will be required to re-verify mainstream preference criteria at the time that your application is selected from the waiting list to ensure program eligibility. Admission into the Anaheim Housing Authority Mainstream program will be based on your eligibility status at the time that your name reaches the top of the list.

The Anaheim Housing Authority complies fully with all federal, state, and local non-discrimination laws and with the rules and regulations governing Fair Housing and Equal Opportunity in housing and employment. The Anaheim Housing Authority shall not deny any family or individual the opportunity to apply for, or to receive, assistance under the HCV Program on the basis of race, color, sex, religion, creed, national or ethnic origin, age, family or marital status, handicap or disability, or sexual orientation.
