1 After considering the moving papers filed in this action, the Court finds that this is a proper
2 case for issuance of an order to show cause, and that, unless the Court issues a temporary
3 restraining order, Plaintiff City of Anaheim will suffer irreparable injury before the matter can be
4 heard on formal notice.

7 1. Defendant Angels Baseball, L.P. appear before this Court on January ____,¹ 2005
8 at _____ a.m./p.m. to show cause why a preliminary injunction should not be issued to
9 enjoin Defendant Angels Baseball, L.P., and its affiliated entities, officers, employees, agents,
10 and/or contractors, and all persons acting under, in concert with, or for it, are enjoined and
11 restrained from any actions or conduct to implement a change in the name of the baseball team,
12 that has been officially named the Anaheim Angels from 1997 to 2004, to the Los Angeles Angels
13 of Anaheim, including but not limited to any actions or conduct to use the name Los Angeles
14 Angels or Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim as the current team name in its advertising, publicity,
15 tickets, parking passes, media guides, calendars, contracts, uniforms, merchandising, souvenirs,
16 website, or other mediums where the current team name is identified or used.

17 *Temporary Restraining Order*

18 2. Pending the hearing on the Order to Show Cause, Defendant Angels Baseball, L.P.,
19 and its affiliated entities, officers, employees, agents, and/or contractors, and all persons acting
20 under, in concert with, or for it, are enjoined and restrained from any actions or conduct to
21 implement a change in the name of the baseball team, that has been officially named the Anaheim
22 Angels from 1997 to 2004, to the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim, including but not limited to
23 any actions or conduct to use the name Los Angeles Angels or Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim as
24 the current team name in its advertising, publicity, tickets, parking passes, media guides,
25 calendars, contracts, uniforms, merchandising, souvenirs, website, or other mediums where the
26 current team name is identified or used.

28 ¹ Pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 527(d)(1), the show cause hearing for the preliminary injunction, or "return date," must be set for no later than 15 days after the date the TRO is issued, or for 22 days after for good cause.
