Within this historic 19 acres you will find many landmarks of the past, including a beautiful amphitheater and ballfield stadium grandstand, both built in 1927, as well as the remarkable cactus and water gardens created in 1921 by Mr. Rudy Boysen, father of the “Boysenberry.”
