## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City of Anaheim is considering a recommendation that the project herein identified will have no significant environmental impact in compliance with Section 15070 of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines. A copy of the **NEGATIVE DECLARATION** and the **INITIAL STUDY** which supports the proposed findings are on file at the City of Anaheim.

**Project Description:** The City of Anaheim is proposing to develop an approximately one-acre passive, interpretive park to complement two existing historical homes and a landmark Moreton Bay Fig tree. The project site consists of four residential lots owned by the City. The project will include construction of a carriage house that will serve as museum space for historic artifacts, a restroom building with a façade resembling a historic pump house and a full-sized windmill. Other proposed amenities include decorative fencing, water pump, sun dial, historical gardens, concrete and decomposed granite walkways/trails with interpretive panels, and a permeable parking lot. The project will also include demolition of four existing non-historical structures.


