

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-134

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF ANAHEIM REVISING FEES FOR  
SERVICES RENDERED BY THE ANAHEIM  
FIRE DEPARTMENT AND ESTABLISHING  
THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF FEES.

WHEREAS, the City Council has heretofore adopted a fee schedule for services rendered by the Anaheim Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to approve a revised fee schedule and establish the effective date of said fees; and

WHEREAS, the fees so established and the categories so modified have been considered at a duly noticed public meeting or hearing as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds that said fees, in the amounts hereinafter set forth in Exhibit "A" are less than or equal to, but in no event greater than, the actual direct and indirect costs and expenses incurred by the City in performing the services connected with such fees; and

WHEREAS, the City Council further finds and determines that this establishment and amendment to fees is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 21080(b)8 of the California Public Resources Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Anaheim as follows:

1. The fees set forth in the fee schedules attached hereto as Exhibit "A" shall be, and the same are, hereby adopted.
2. The fees established herein shall become effective sixty (60) days following the date of adoption of this Resolution.
3. The fees established herein shall, upon the effective date of said fees, supersede fees set forth in Resolution No. 2009-115 and any previously adopted fees for the same permit or approval.

4. The City Council hereby declares that should any one or more fees established by this Resolution or any portion of this Resolution be declared for any reason to be invalid, it is the intent of the City Council that it would have adopted all other fees and portions of this Resolution independent of the elimination herefrom of any such fee or such portion as may be declared invalid.





Additional inspection hours will be invoiced separately and charged at a rate of \$15.00 per 1/4 hour for inspections that occur during normal business hours. Additional inspections that take place after 5:00 PM and on weekends will be charged at a rate of \$46.00 per hour (2-hour minimum on weekends and after 5:00 pm).

**IV. Inspection Fees for Annual Fire Inspections Conducted by the Fire Prevention Bureau:**

Initial Inspection. Annual Fire Inspections performed by the Fire Prevention Bureau are performed at an hourly rate. \$220 per hour

Reinspection. Reinspections to gain compliance with the initial correction notice are performed at an hourly rate. \$220 per hour

Mail-Back Card Program. Failure to return the mail-back card issued for violations found during the initial fire department inspection will result in a reinspection being conducted and charged. \$110

Pre-inspection for State Regulated facilities. A fee to conduct a pre-inspection of State Regulated facilities prior to the final fire Clearance request. Includes "Community Care Homes", "Residential Care Homes for the Elderly", and "Child Day Care Facilities". This fee standard is set by the California Health and Safety Code Section 13235. \$55 per 1/4 hour of actual inspection time

**V. False Alarms:**

False Alarms-Failure to Notify

Fire department response due to failure to notify fire department when working on or testing sprinkler or alarm systems.

\$250 for each occurrence

Intentional Activation

Intentional activation of alarm where no emergency exists.

\$250 for each occurrence

Malfunctions

Alarm system malfunction resulting in fire department response more than twice within a 30-day period, or in excess of three occurrences within any six month period.

\$250 for each specified occurrence

Stand-by fee. This fee is applicable only for those instances when the Fire Marshal determines that Stand-by personnel are needed to mitigate an exigent circumstance.

1. Required Fire Department Stand-by during normal business hours are performed at an hourly rate.

\$45 per hour

2. Required Fire Department Stand-by after 5:00 PM and on Weekends.

\$60 per hour (minimum 2- hr on weekends)

Microfiche

1. Copies made from microfiche, 8 1/2" x 14" or less.

Actual cost charged by outside company

45 Day Penalty

Failure to submit fees within forty-five (45) days of original billing.

Additional 10% penalty

Weed Abatement Administrative Charge/Fee:

Failure to Remove Weeds or Accumulations of Trash, Grass, Weeds, Litter, Flammable or Combustible Materials from a Courtyard, Vacant Lot or Space by the Third Notice will result in a Administrative Fee Being Added to the Contractors Bill for Each Parcel.

\$325 for each Parcel
