Specifications and Requirements

Subject: FIREWORKS, SPECIAL EFFECTS AND PYROTECHNIC DEVICES

References: California Health and Safety Code, Sections 12500 – 12726; California Code of Regulations, Title 19; Chapter 6, Anaheim Municipal Code 6.40 and 6.41, Resolution 2006-143

All fireworks activities including public display aerial fireworks, pyrotechnics, and special effects require a permit from the Anaheim Fire Department.

Basic Requirements

The following requirements must be fulfilled in order to obtain a permit.

- 1) A public fireworks display application shall be obtained from the Anaheim Fire Department's Fire Prevention Bureau.
- 2) Sections one (1) through six (6) on the application must be completed before the application will be processed.
- 3) All fireworks shall be stored in an approved magazine at a location approved by the Anaheim Fire Department.
- 4) A minimum of two weeks must be given to process the application. If a 14 day advanced notice is not received, the permit fee will be doubled.

Fireworks Permit Fee-\$50.00 per ¼ hour base-rate time and an inspection fee of :
\$100.00 per hour base-rate time during business hours
or
\$54.00 per ¼ hour base-rate time after business hours
(If submitted less than 14 days prior to event, fees are doubled.)

The Fire Prevention Bureau cannot guarantee late submittals will be processed in time for the event.

Additional Requirements

After the permit has been granted a pre-display walk-through and demonstration of some devices may be required. Therefore, it is advisable to have extra devices on hand.
