Specifications and Requirements

**Subject: PUBLIC FIREWORKS DISPLAYS**

**References: California Health and Safety Code, Sections 12500 – 12726; California Code of Regulations, Title 19; Chapter 6, Anaheim Municipal Code 6.40 and 6.41, Resolution 2006-143**

All fireworks activities including aerial fireworks, pyrotechnics, and special effects for motion picture productions require a permit from the Anaheim Fire Department.

Basic Requirements

The following requirements must be fulfilled in order to obtain a permit.

- 1) An application for a fireworks permit shall be obtained from the Anaheim Fire Department's Fire Prevention Bureau.
- 2) Sections 1 through 6 on the application must be completed before the application will be processed.
- 3) All fireworks shall be stored in an approved magazine at a location approved by the Fire Department.
- 4) A permit fee will be charged.
- 5) A minimum of two weeks must be given to process the application.  
If a fourteen (14) day advanced notice is not received, the application fee will be doubled per day.

**The Fire Prevention Bureau cannot guarantee late submittals will be processed in time for the event.**

Additional Requirements

After the permit has been granted a pre-display walk-through and demonstration of some devices may be required. Therefore, it is advisable to have extra devices on hand.

Standby Personnel

Inspection charges will be assessed depending on the day and time of the demonstration or display. A two (2) hour minimum fee will be charged for demonstrations or displays during weekend hours. Demonstrations or displays conducted after regular business hours (from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday) will be charged an overtime fee.
