Fall is in the air, which means Open Enrollment is almost here! Your once-a-year opportunity to change your City-sponsored benefits will be **October 3rd through October 17th**.

For now, keep an eye on your mailbox because you'll soon receive detailed information about your 2012 benefit options and the steps you must take to complete the enrollment process.

What's Happening in 2012

We're pleased to announce there will be **no** medical/vision or dental plan changes in your 2012 retiree benefits! Also, the City was successful in keeping rates low. For most retirees, this means you won't see an increase in the cost of your coverage. Early retirees on the Kaiser plans and all of the post-65 retirees will see a slight increase in the cost for their coverage.

Use Preventive Care Benefits

One way to continue to keep costs down is for all retirees to take advantage of the medical plans' preventive care benefits. Remember, the City and your medical plans provide a range of discounted and free services including health checks and flu shots. Take charge of your health, and use these City-sponsored benefits to improve your overall health and wellness.



What You Need to Do

Open Enrollment is a good time to review all available benefit plans and choose the plan that best suits your needs and budget. For more information about your 2012 plan options and what to do during the Open Enrollment period, be sure to review the City's *2012 Benefits Guide*. You'll receive your copy by mail in early October.
