



## City of Anaheim's 150th Anniversary Time Capsule Contest

On September 9, 2007 the City of Anaheim will continue celebrating its 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary by unearthing a time capsule that has been buried since the City's Centennial in 1957. The City will also dedicate a new time capsule as part of its Sesquicentennial Celebration. In order to assist in the selection of items for the new time capsule, a contest has been created to choose children to represent the "youth of Anaheim, as they help decide what will be placed in the time capsule.

### Entry Rules:

- Any student living or attending school in Anaheim, in grades 1-12.
- The official entry form must be completed, including name, address, grade level/school, name of item, and a brief description of why it should be included in the new time capsule (not to exceed 200 words). A parent or guardian must sign the entry form.
- One entry per student. Photocopies of the entry form are permitted.
- Item must not be larger than a tissue box or weigh more than five pounds. Participant does not need to supply item.
- The entries must be mailed to: 150 Time Capsule Contest, P.O. Box 927, Anaheim, CA 92815, and received no later than August 15, 2007.
- Entries will be judged by a panel of volunteer judges.
- The winners will have their item added to the time capsule and will be recognized at the Time Capsule Celebration on September 9, 2007.
