If you enjoy teamwork, learning new skills in a fun and exciting environment, and are interested in jump starting your career in the fire service, then we have an opportunity for you.

Fire Explorers learn Fire Fighting Skills, hose lay evolutions, ladder techniques, salvage operations, wildland firefighting procedures, proper use of tools and equipment, basic first aid, and leadership skills that can be applied to any career.

Fire Explorers meet twice a month on midweek days from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. and one weekend morning per month from 9:00 a.m. to noon, as needed. After Explorers have met the minimum requirements they have the opportunity to experience what the job really requires through the Ride Along Program. During a Ride Along Explorers are side by side professional Firefighters and respond to actual fires and emergencies. Whether it's riding on the Paramedic Engines, Ladder Trucks, or performing an inspection there will always be an activity that is scheduled for their experience.
