Classification:
PARK MAINTENANCE WORKER II

Definition: Under moderate supervision guides the work of Park Maintenance Worker I's and participates in the work of installing and maintaining landscaped areas in parks, parkways, city buildings and other city facilities.

Examples of Essential Job Functions:

Assists the Park Field Supervisor in coordinating and carrying out the work of a park maintenance crew.

Completes forms related to work assignments and supervises work of crews in completing assigned work tasks.

Acts in the capacity of the Park Field Supervisor in that persons absence.

Inspects, repairs, replaces, reroutes and operates automatic and manual irrigation systems, including the ability to program controllers.

Grades, drags, lines and waters ball diamonds and cleans and replaces mounds and bases.
Lays out and maintains sports fields, i.e. baseball, softball, football and soccer.

Repairs and maintains various park fixtures, i.e. fences, bleachers, backstops, playground equipment and drinking fountains.

Pours concrete pads, curbs, walkways; constructs planter boxes, retaining wall and lays brick paving.

Fertilizes and sprays turf, trees and shrubs with herbicides and insecticides.

Waters parks, tree wells, medians and parkways.

Installs and resods; mows, edges, rakes and waters turf. Plants and prunes trees, shrubs and bushes.

Operates a variety of light equipment such as mowers, skip loaders, tractors with attachments such as fertilizers, aerifiers and seeders.

Provides service station type maintenance to motorized equipment and maintains the required service records.

Maintains pools, fountains and other water features.

Prepares and co-ordinates use of facilities for public and recreation events.

Participates and directs the work of various 2 or 3 person specialty crews.

Meets with and responds to questions from the public.

Performs related duties as required.

Minimum Requirements:

Experience: Journey-level landscaping experience.

Knowledge of: Use of common tools and equipment; principles of landscaping and supervisory techniques.

Skill in: Use of hand and power tools and light motorized equipment; properly laying out and maintain sports fields, i.e. baseball, softball, football and soccer; programming controllers to ensure proper operation of irrigation systems; dealing diplomatically with the public and park users; establishing and maintaining effective working relationships; communicating effectively, both verbally and in writing; following written and verbal instructions, providing effective leadership to assigned employees..

License and/or Certification Required: Possession of, or ability to obtain a valid Class "C" California Driver's License by date of appointment.

Physical Requirements: Must be able to stand, walk, use both hands, arms and legs, bend, stoop, climb, and lift up to 50 pounds and to maintain physical exertion daily for long periods of time, sometimes in inclement weather.

Supervision Received: Works under technical supervision of a Park Field Supervisor who gives assignments and periodically reviews work in progress and completed work.

Supervision Exercised: May guide the work of Park Maintenance Worker I's and Laborers, directs specialty crews, and directs the entire crew in the supervisor's absence.

Career Ladder Information: Experience in this class may serve to meet minimum requirements for promotion to Park Field Supervisor.

All requirements are subject to possible modification to reasonably accommodate individuals with disabilities.
