Classification:
PARK MAINTENANCE WORKER I

Definition: Under moderate supervision installs and maintains landscaped areas in parks, parkways, city buildings and and other city facilities.

Examples of Essential Job Functions:

Inspects, installs, repairs, replaces, reroutes and operates automatic and manual irrigation systems.

Grades, drags, lines and waters ball diamonds and cleans and replaces mounds and bases.

Repairs and maintains fences, bleachers, backstops, playground equipment and drinking fountains.

Pours concrete pads, curbs, walkways; constructs planter boxes, retaining wall and lays brick paving.

Fertilizes and sprays turf, trees and shrubs with herbicides and insecticides.

Waters parks, tree wells, medians and parkways.

Installs, resods, mows, edges, rakes and waters turf. Plants and prunes trees, shrubs and bushes.

Operates a variety of light equipment such as turf vacuums, mowers, skip loaders, tractors with implements such as fertilizers, aerifiers, seeders, and other equipment.

Cleans and maintains motorized equipment and tools; sharpens blades, bed knives, chain saws, drill bits. Steam cleans, welds, and performs preventative maintenance of equipment.

Cleans and maintains areas such as parks, parkways, ball fields, courts, walkways, public restrooms at these facilities, dam faces, reservoirs, berms and median strips.

Maintains pools, fountains and other water features.

Prepares and co-ordinates use of facilities for public and recreation events.

Checks equipment in and out and receives supplies.

Meets and responds to questions from the public.

Performs related duties as required.

Minimum Requirements:

Knowledge of: Use of common tools and equipment and principles of landscaping.

Skill in: Use of hand and power tools and light motorized equipment; dealing diplomatically with the public and park users; establishing and maintaining effective working relationships and following written and verbal instructions.

License and/or Certification Required: Class "C" California Driver's License.

Physical Requirements: Ability to stand, walk, use both hands, arms and legs, bend, stoop, climb, and lift up to 50 pounds and to maintain physical exertion daily for long periods of time, sometimes in inclement weather.

Supervision Received: Works under the technical supervision of a Park Field Supervisor and/or Park Maintenance Worker II, who gives assignments and periodically reviews work in progress and completed work.

Supervision Exercised: May sometimes guide the work of laborers.

Career Ladder Information: Experience in this class may serve to meet minimum requirements for promotion to Park Maintenance Worker II.
