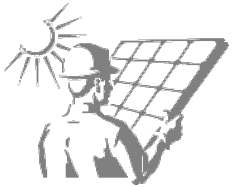

Green Power for the Grid

“Green power” refers to electricity generated from renewable energy sources such as wind and solar power, geothermal (steam), various forms of biomass (organic waste), landfill gas and hydroelectric power. While these resources provide an unlimited supply of environmentally friendly energy, they also are more expensive than conventional energy sources such as coal and natural gas.

The support of hundreds of our customers, who have signed up for our Green Power program, has helped us to bring more green electricity to Anaheim while keeping our overall rates among the lowest in California.

Green Power for the Grid helps bring electricity generated at renewable resources located near Anaheim and as far away as Northern California, Montana and southern Utah - renewable energy delivered to our community over the regional electric grid. Your contribution not only benefits you directly, it also benefits all of Anaheim’s customers by increasing various types of renewable generation in Anaheim’s power resource portfolio.

How the Program Works

2. You select the amount you wish to contribute each 30-day billing period. Your options are:

Residential Customers:

- a. \$1.50 b. \$3.00 c. \$4.50

Business Customers:

- a. \$15 b. \$30 c. \$45

3. The contribution will be added to your utility bill and will be invested in green, renewable power resources for our community.
