



SUN POWER FOR THE SCHOOLS

Sun Power for the Schools is an Anaheim Public Utilities Program that offers Anaheim schools financial grants to assist with the installation of solar energy systems on Anaheim school campuses. This exciting Anaheim Public Utilities program supports clean, quiet electric generation along with unique educational opportunities for every school in Anaheim.

The program started in 2002 and has had eight participating schools including participation from three public districts including Anaheim City School District, Placentia-Yorba Linda Unified School District and Magnolia School District.

Program Criteria:

- Sun Power for the Schools grants cover up to 80% of the cost of the school solar energy project
- Grants are limited to \$150,000 for each grant application
- Applications are limited to one application per Anaheim school campus
- Schools must submit a written [Sun Power for the Schools Request for Grant](#) in order to receive funding

Eligibility:

- Sun Power for the Schools grant awards are limited to k-12 schools
- Both public and private schools are eligible to apply for Sun Power for the Schools grants
- Schools must be recognized by the Orange County Department of Education and registered to the State of California
