**APPLICABILITY**

Applicable to all consumers of water within the area served by the Utility for private firelines used for fire protection whether said lines are connected with automatic sprinkling systems or private fire hydrants.

If consumer, in the opinion of the Utility, is using water in a volume that cannot be recorded on the bypass meter, the Utility will discontinue service until a meter is installed (at customer's expense) to record all water used.
