

**ELECTRIC RATES, RULES

**DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEDULE WTR**

**WIRELESS TECHNOLOGY RATE**

**APPLICABILITY:**

This rate is applicable to single-phase service for wireless technology industries that require electric service to operate radio repeaters or similar devices (wireless communication devices) that are mounted on existing traffic signals and street light facilities and are unmetered. Customers must execute an application / contract with APU for service under this schedule and must execute an applicable agreement when devices are attached to APU owned facilities. The monthly kilowatt-hour (kWh) usage for each device shall not exceed 250 kWh. Effective with the date the customer becomes ineligible for service under this Schedule, the customer's account shall transfer immediately to Schedule GS-1.

This developmental schedule may be extended, modified or closed at the direction of the APU General Manager, upon notification of City Council or upon City Council approval to offer such services under a permanent Schedule. Barring any action described above, this developmental schedule will sunset December 31, 2009.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS (Continued):

C. Three phase service:

When in the sole opinion of APU, it is impractical to provide single phase service under this Schedule; three phase service will be provided.

D. Determination of Monthly Usage:

The customer must provide APU information from which APU can determine the level of kWh usage to be consumed and / or level of service to be provided; such as device nameplate rating and the number of devices to be installed. APU will place the customer in the appropriate usage tier and charge according to the maximum value of that tier. APU retains the right to perform on-site inspections to verify the energy consumption of the device(s).

E. Installation:

The device(s) shall be installed on traffic signals and street light facilities. The installation and removal of such device(s) will be performed by the customer at the customer's expense. Device installation shall be performed where location, mounting height and / or other considerations is acceptable to City standards.

F. Modifications:

Where the customer requests a modification of traffic signals and street light facilities, and such modifications are acceptable to APU, APU will perform the requested modifications at the customer's expense.

G. Maintenance:

APU shall exercise reasonable care and diligence in maintaining its traffic signals and street light facilities. Upon installation of device(s) where APU experiences or expects to experience maintenance costs exceeding its normal expense to maintain its facilities, APU may require the customer to pay the excess maintenance.

H. Billing:

A customer's bill is calculated according to the rates and conditions listed above. The customer is responsible, subject to APU audit to report all additions to / removals from APU facilities.

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS** (Continued):

I. Interruptions:

As described in Rule 14 B, APU will exercise reasonable diligence to furnish a continuous and sufficient supply of electricity and to minimize the occurrences of outages; however APU does not guarantee a continuous or sufficient supply or freedom from such conditions which may affect the electricity provided. APU will exercise reasonable diligence to reinstitute the delivery of electricity.

J. General Manager:

The APU general manager may implement, modify, extend, restrict or close this developmental schedule upon notification and approval of City Council and the customer will be transferred to the otherwise applicable rate.

To: Anaheim Public Utilities Department (APU):

The undersigned applicant hereby requests APU to supply electric service and to deliver electric energy to and for the equipment hereinafter described in accordance with the applicable rates and rules of APU including the tariff set forth.

Applicant agrees to the following:

1. Applicant agrees to comply with rates and rules and with any changes or modifications thereof which may be authorized by the City Council of Anaheim.
2. Applicant agrees to take and pay for unmetered service under Experimental Schedule WTR based on fixed usage categories and one customer charge per month.
3. Applicant grants APU right of way as required by APU.
4. Applicant will install per City standards and City inspection and load control device that will ensure that Applicant does not exceed the fixed used categories.
5. Any other Safety / Engineering requirements.
6. Applicant agrees that once the maximum kWh of a tier has been exceeded, APU may immediately move applicant to the next available tier.
7. APU will review rate on or before December 31, 2009 and review the applicability of a permanent rate given future unknown requirements of wireless technology.
8. The contract rate is subject to rate changes approved by Council or changes in the Power Cost Rate Stabilization Account charge.
9.
