1. **CALL TO ORDER:** The Youth Commission meeting was called to order at 4:07 p.m. by Brian Chwan.
2. **OATH OF OFFICE:** All Youth Commissioners present have completed an Oath of Office.
3. **PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:** Brian Chwan led the Commission in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Brian Chwan presented the December 8, 2021 minutes to the Youth Commissioners for changes and/or corrections. Commissioner Ortiz made a motion to approve the December 8, 2021 meeting minutes, seconded by Commissioner Zewdu; motion was approved with six votes in favor. Brian Chwan accepted the minutes.

7. **NEW BUSINESS:**
  - a) Nominations and Voting for Chair and Vice Chair- Brian Chwan
