Canyon Power Project

The City entered into a Power Sales
Agreement with Southern California
Public Power Authority for all of the 200
MW nameplate capacity and energy from
the Canyon Power Project (CPP). The
CPP is a conventional simple cycle,
natural gas-fired peaking facility
comprised of four combustion turbine
generators located in the Canyon
industrial area of Anaheim.

CPP provides enhanced local reliability and is dispatched when its generation costs are less than the cost to serve Anaheim's load.
