  - a. Anaheim ballot initiatives,
  - b. changes to the Anaheim municipal minimum wage,
  - c. hotel companies that do business in the city of Anaheim, including but not limited to the Walt Disney Company and any affiliates, Prospera Hotels, Inc. and any affiliates, and Wincome group and any affiliates,
  - d. the Anaheim Chamber of Commerce,
  - e. labor unions that represent employees at the Disneyland resort and hotels, including but not limited to UNITE HERE, UFCW, SEIU, Workers United, IATSE, AFM, and USWW,

f. and hotel companies that have received city subsidies, including but not limited to the Walt Disney Company and any affiliates, Prospera Hotels, Inc. and any affiliates, and Wincome group and any affiliates.

As provided in the open records law, I will expect your response within ten (10) business days. If you determine that any part of my request is better suited for another government body, I ask that you please let me know to which body I should direct my request.

If you believe a portion of the information I have requested from disclosure by express provisions of the law, Government Code Section 6257 additionally requires segregation and deletion of that material in order that the remainder of the information may be released.

If I can provide any clarification that will help expedite your attention to my request, please contact me at . I ask that you notify me of any duplication costs exceeding \$50 before you duplicate the records so that I may decide which records I want copied. Any records that can be provided electronically can be forwarded to

If you choose to deny this request, please provide a written explanation for the denial including a reference to the specific statutory exemption(s) upon which you rely.
