Re: **Intelligent Transportations Systems Traffic Signal Emergency
Vehicle Preemption (EVP) Improvement Projects
("The Project")**

To Whom It May Concern:

Our office represents a party with a claim against a party which either directly contracted or sub-contracted with the City to perform work on traffic signal technology for the city's emergency vehicles.

Pursuant to the Public Records Act (Govt. Code section 6250 et seq.), we request specific documents regarding public works projects which may have been completed as result of contracts between the City of Anaheim and certain contractors for work characterized by the following:

1. Installation, repair, maintenance, or improvement of the city's intelligent transportation systems (ITS) for traffic signal emergency vehicle preemption (EVP) technology.
2. The type of technology used for these public works projects includes Global Traffic Technologies (GTT) Opticom system components to allow emergency vehicles, such as fire department vehicles, to seek temporary rights of way through the use of infrared and/or GPS technology.
3. These projects may have been paid through the budgets of the city's department of public works and/or the city's fire department.

4. Installation, maintenance, or repair of this traffic signal technology may have begun as early as 2013 and as recently as 2018.

The following companies may have directly contracted with the city and, therefore, would be the named party to whom the city had paid public funds in exchange for performance of The Project:

The requested categories of documents are specifically described and defined below, which include:

1. The General Contract;
2. The Project Payment Bond;
3. The Project Performance Bond;
4. Any Notice of Completions related to The Project
5. All applications for financing for The Project;
6. All reports related to financing for The Project;
7. All finance agreements related to financing The Project including any project finance agreements; and
8. All documents related to conditions for financing The Project, including any and all general and special conditions related to labor standards for work on The Project

In addition to the information described above, we have attached a document apparently created by the City which relates to the information that we seek. Please see the document enclosed with this request.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council, by Motion, waive the sealed bid requirement of Council Policy 4.0 and authorize the Purchasing Agent to issue a purchase order to DDL Traffic, Inc., Chino, California, in the amount of \$98,585.10 for the purchase and installation Global Traffic Technologies (GTT) Opticom system components for the expansion of the City's Emergency Vehicle Preemption (EVP) Traffic Systems.

DISCUSSION:

In January of this year, the City Council authorized the purchase of GTT Opticom EVP equipment from DDL Traffic, Inc. to be installed in 13 intersections within the City. EVP systems allow the normal operation of traffic lights to be altered in order to provide the safe and controlled passage of emergency vehicles through signalized intersections when responding to emergency calls. EVP studies show that an effective signal preemption system improves emergency response times by an average of 20% while simultaneously reducing collisions at controlled intersections.

The current FY 2014/15 operating budget includes funding to expand the City's EVP systems, in accordance with the Fire Department's Strategic Plan, and the Public Works Department's Intelligent Transportation Systems Master Plan. Prior to the first equipment purchase, Public Works and the Fire Department determined that the Opticom equipment best meets the needs of the City of Anaheim. Therefore, staff recommends utilizing the same equipment components for any additional system expansion.

DDL Traffic is the sole source distributor for GTT Opticom products in Southern California; hence it is not possible to competitively bid this purchase. However, DDL and GTT Opticom have agreed to provide a 10% discount off the manufacturer's suggested unit price for up to 36 months to allow the City to complete the desired traffic signal communications system improvements. This year's budget appropriation of \$100,000 will provide for an additional 15 intersections to be equipped with EVP systems. Staff requests authorization for the Purchasing Agent to make this, and future

purchases necessary to complete the project, from GTT in accordance with the current guaranteed pricing structure and each year's approved budget appropriations, without returning to Council for approval of each additional purchase order.

IMPACT ON BUDGET:

A supplemental budget appropriation was approved by Council on June 17, 2014; therefore, sufficient funds are available in the Fire Department's FY 2014/15 budget. Future years will be subject to Council's approval of budget appropriations.
