- Serve as project manager for transportation mobility study within the City
- Serve as staff to committees such as the Anaheim Tourism Improvement District (ATID) Transportation Committee; prepare and present staff reports and other necessary correspondence.

The ideal candidate is a profession in the transportation field who has exceptional communication, interpersonal skills, and possesses broad experience in all areas of transportation planning, project management, transit planning, and grant management. In addition, candidates should have a proven track record of innovation, creativity, and building strong relationships with the community, residents, and employees. In addition, candidates must demonstrated expertise in the following areas:

- Strong commitment to customer service, collaboration, and fostering relationships
- Proactive and innovative ideas to find creative solutions to Anaheim’s unique challenges

The Department seeks a Principal Planner that should have a personality and management style that is:

- Collaborative and creative in problem solving

Primary Essential Functions

- Plan, prioritize, assign, supervise, review, and participate in the work of staff responsible for providing transportation planning services within the Public Works Department; oversee and manage consultant and contractor work product.
- Participate in and oversee regional coordination activities; review a variety of Federal, State and local policies, and programs related to traffic and transportation planning.
- Manage transportation planning studies; prepare and review a variety of narrative and statistical reports related to the operation and administration of transportation programs, including maps, charts, and other graphics; review environmental impact reports and traffic and parking studies; prepare and present written and verbal reports to the Planning Commission and City Council.
- Provide oversight and administration of City franchise agreements.
- Participate in, and represent the City on, a variety of boards and committees, including multi-jurisdictional transit committees, the Anaheim Tourism Improvement District (ATID) Transportation Committee, and other local and regional boards.
- Interpret and apply codes, laws, City policies, procedures, and ordinances to ensure compliance; communicate codes, laws, regulations, and technical transportation planning information to the public, elected officials, appointed commissioners and developers.



Qualifications


Experience and Education: Four (4) years of responsible professional experience in transportation and transit planning, including one year of administrative and/or lead supervisory experience, supplemented by a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with major course work in planning, engineering, or related field. An equivalent combination of experience and education sufficient to perform the essential job functions and provide the required knowledge and abilities is qualifying.

License/Certification Required:

- Possession of an appropriate, valid driver's license and one of the following: State of California registration as a Professional Civil Engineer, State of California registration as a Professional Traffic Engineer, American Institute of Certified Planner (AICP) certificate, or Professional Transportation Planner (PTP) certificate.
