On behalf of the American Civil Liberties Union Foundation of Southern California, I write to request records containing information regarding the enforcement of Anaheim Municipal Code ("AMC") §§ 11.10.030, 11.10.040, 7.28.010, 7.16.010, 7.16.040, 7.30.030; all AMC bicycle-related codes; California Vehicle Code §§ 21200, 21200.5, 21201, 21205, 21208(a), and 21650.1; and California Penal Code §§ 602, and 647(e) in the City of Anaheim, as well as the fines and fees charged to and collected from these individuals. This request is made pursuant to the California Public Records Act, Government Code §6250, et seq. and the California Constitution, as amended by passage of Prop. 59 on November 3, 2004.

Please forward us any and all records containing information regarding alleged infractions or violations of AMC §§ 11.10.030, 11.10.040, 7.28.010, 7.16.010, 7.16.040, 7.30.030, all AMC bicycle-related codes; California Vehicle Code §§ 21200, 21200.5, 21201, 21205, 21208(a), and 21650.1; California Penal Code §§ 602 and 647(e), and any documents related to fines and fees for violating Anaheim municipal ordinances, including but not limited to fines and fees charged to and collected from these individuals and Anaheim's criminal fine and fee schedule. Please provide this information for the period from January 1, 2016 through the date of this request, including but not limited to records containing information regarding:

1. Copies of citations and any other records of arrests made, or civil actions instituted for alleged violations of AMC §§ 11.10.030, 11.10.040, 7.28.010, 7.16.010, 7.16.040, 7.30.030; all AMC bicycle-related codes; California Vehicle Code §§ 21200, 21200.5, 21201, 21205, 21208(a), and 21650.1; and California Penal Code §§ 602 and 647(e).
2. For each incident where an individual was issued a citation for an alleged violation of AMC §§ 11.10.030, 11.10.040, 7.28.010, 7.16.010, 7.16.040, 7.30.030; all AMC bicycle-

related codes; California Vehicle Code §§ 21200, 21200.5, 21201, 21205, 21208(a), and 21650.1; and California Penal Code §§ 602 and 647(e):

- a. The name of the person arrested or cited.
  - b. A description of the incident leading to the arrest or citation.
  - c. The location and time of arrest or citation.
  - d. The identity of the police officers involved.
3. Any documents related to fines and fees for violating Anaheim municipal ordinances, including but not limited to fines and fees charged to and collected from these individuals and Anaheim's criminal fine and fee schedule.

The California Public Records Act requires a response within 10 days of your receipt of this request. To the extent that your office claims the right to withhold any record, or portion of any record, please describe each and every record or portion that is being withheld and the claimed reason for exemption, citing the exact language of the Public Records Act on which you rely. Because the ACLU is a nonprofit civil rights organization, we request that you waive any fees that would be normally applicable to a Public Records Act request. *See N. County Parents Org. v. Dep't of Educ.*, 23 Cal. App. 4th 144, 146 (1994). No part of the information obtained will be distributed or sold for profit.
