Registration and Waivers

- ★ Registration will open on June 25th, 2020 at 8:00 a.m.
- ★ This exciting camp is only being offered to children of full-time and part-time City of Anaheim employees. This week-long day camp is filled with adventure and fun for children ages 7-12 years old. Children will enjoy activities including crafts, games, sports, and special entertainment. - ★ Online pre-registration and waiver acceptance is **required**. To register, please set up your online account at anaheim.net/play and then email Sarah Randall at srandall@anaheim.net to verify employment as a full-time employee. After being a verified, call (714) 765-5191 to register. Waivers will be emailed and must be submitted before camp begins.

Camp Ratios & Groups

- ★ Group sizes will not exceed 10. Groups will include up to nine campers and one camp counselor, or up to eight campers and one camp counselor with one teen volunteer.

Participants will remain with the same group and camp counselors for the entire week. Family members will remain in the same group.

- ★ During the online registration process we will have the option to list the name of a fellow camper your child would like to be grouped with. Please keep in mind that children are grouped by age. Buddy requests are not guaranteed, but we do our best to accommodate.
- ★ Groups will be designated by color and assigned a specific area in the park to use.
- ★ Each group area will have canopies for shade, tables, chairs and supplies as needed for the day.

Health & Safety Guidelines

- ★ The City of Anaheim and its venues continue to do their part to stem the spread of coronavirus. Due to the safety guidelines currently in effect, please be aware that all of the following information is subject to change without notice.
- ★ Under the Governor's reopening guidance, all campers are required to wear cloth face coverings. Please bring and expect to wear a face mask or covering for the safety of you and others.
- ★ Temperature and wellness check of camper will be conducted at the designated drop-off point.
- ★ Photo ID is required at pick-up, which will be at one designated pick-up point. Adult at pick-up must be the same as listed during the online registration process.

We ask that you limit the drop-off/pick-up to the same two guardians, this will help limit the number of people on site.

- ★ Cleaning and sanitation routines will be increased. Staff will be supplied with disinfect spray and hand sanitizer. Hand washing and sanitizing will be frequent and built into the daily schedule.
- ★ If anyone in the participant's household has displayed symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 14 days, we ask you stay home.
- ★ If a participant develops symptoms while at camp, they will be isolated and will need to be picked up immediately. If your child has a fever, they cannot return until they are 72 hours fever free without the aid of medicine, as recommended by the CDC.
- ★ Unfortunately, all excursions and water days at CampVenture have been cancelled. However, we have arranged special entertainment at camp instead.

Games & Supplies

- ★ Each participant will be provided with a bag of supplies for individual use. Supplies will not be shared during the week. No outside toys or games are permitted.

- ★ Games and activities will be structured with little to no physical contact with other campers. All campers will be encouraged maintain social distancing during all games and activities.
- ★ All activities will take place outdoors. With the exception of restrooms, indoor spaces will not be used.
- ★ Each camper will be assigned a box to safely store backpacks, lunches, water bottles, etc.
- ★ All play equipment (balls, hula hoops, jump ropes, etc.) will be disinfected between uses.

Water, Lunch & Snack

- ★ All participants must bring a reusable water bottle. **No food will be served by staff.**
CampVenture Participants: Bring self-contained snacks and lunch.
- ★ Water refill stations will be available for campers to refill personal water bottles in order to avoid the use of drinking fountains.
- ★ Campers will be encouraged to maintain social distancing during lunch and snack time. CampVenture participants are encouraged to bring a small towel to sit on while eating in the shaded grass area.
